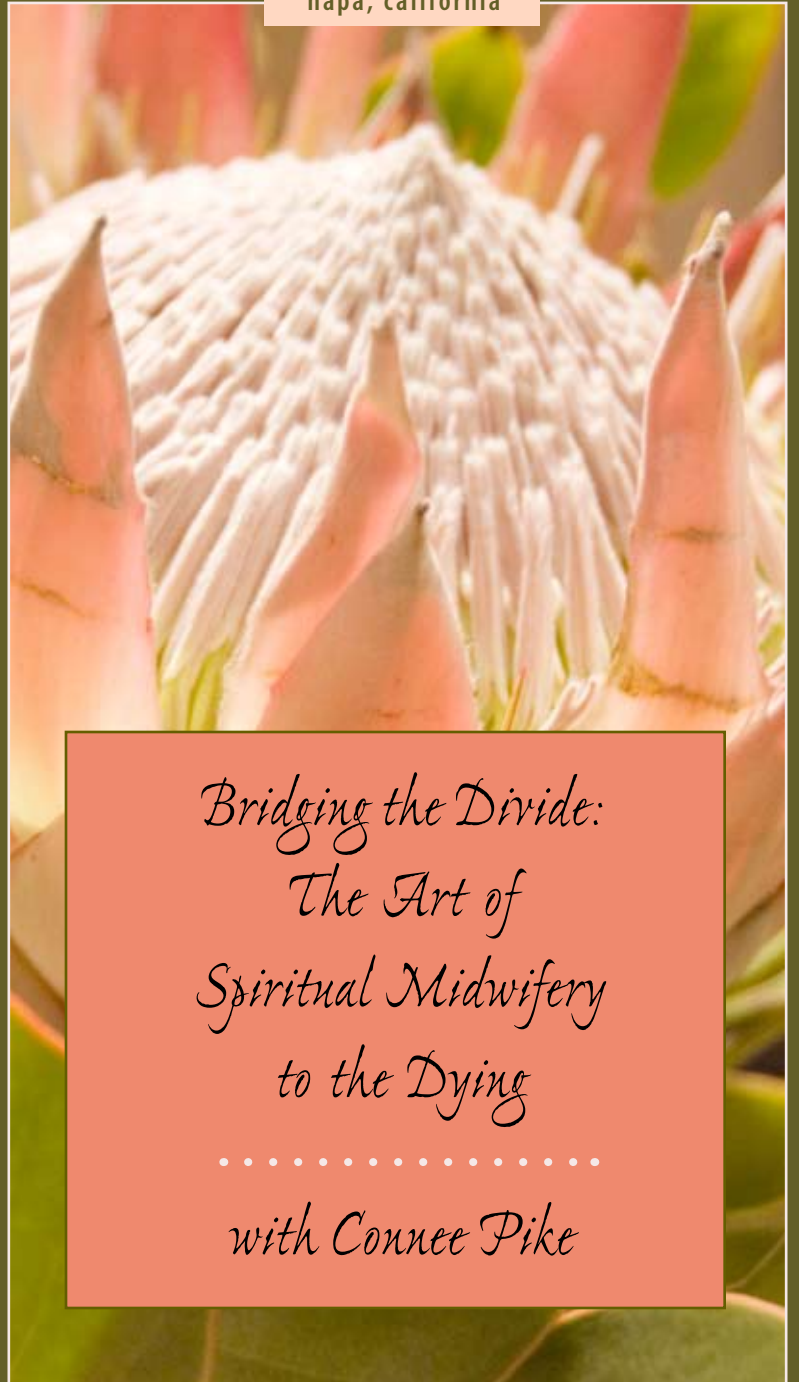

COURSE THEMES AND TOPICS

COMPASSIONATE SERVICE TO THE DYING:

THE UNIVERSALITY OF LOVE.

We will explore the role of spiritual midwife, our relationship to death and dying, and our wish to embark upon this journey. We will examine the spiritual path, what spiritual care means, and how to work with people regardless of cultural-religious backgrounds.

SPIRITUAL PATH OF DYING:

THE SPIRITUAL JOURNEY TO MYSTERY.

We will explore the spiritual journey of dying. We will examine the dissolution process of death, and identify the relationship between the spiritual journey and the dying process.

SPIRITUAL ASSESSMENT:

MEETING PEOPLE WHERE THEY ARE.

We will learn how to identify the spiritual needs of the dying. We will learn how to explore the spiritual/religious beliefs of another, their experiences of Divinity / Mystery, and to assess their spiritual skills.

SPIRITUAL PAIN:

WHAT BLOCKS US FROM DIVINE GRACE.

We will explore the nature of spiritual pain and ways to assess and treat spiritual pain. We will explore the role of pain in our spiritual lives, and how to address spiritual and religious wounds.

NONVERBAL STATES OF CONSCIOUSNESS:

WORKING WITH SPIRIT.

We will learn the spiritual understanding of nonverbal states. We will explore nonverbal states most common to the dying process such as actively dying states, coma states, and alzheimer/dementia. We will learn how to assess the spiritual needs of nonverbal people and provide spiritual support.

CONTEMPLATIVE SPIRITUAL PRESENCE TO THE DYING:

THE MYSTERY AND AWE OF LIFE AND DEATH.

We will further explore tools for providing spiritual care to the dying. We will explore common ethical dilemmas as well as the spiritual needs and experiences of caregivers. We will also discuss ways to provide care after death including care for the body, ritual and memorial services.
